Team Process for Completing ECO Child Summary Form

Participant Objectives:

- Participants will describe how to use multiple measures and sources to complete the Child Outcomes Summary Form (COSF).
- Participants will understand how to complete the COSF, including completing summary of relevant information and determining child ratings in the three child outcome areas.
- Participants will utilize a decision tree for summary rating discussions during their team decision process.
