

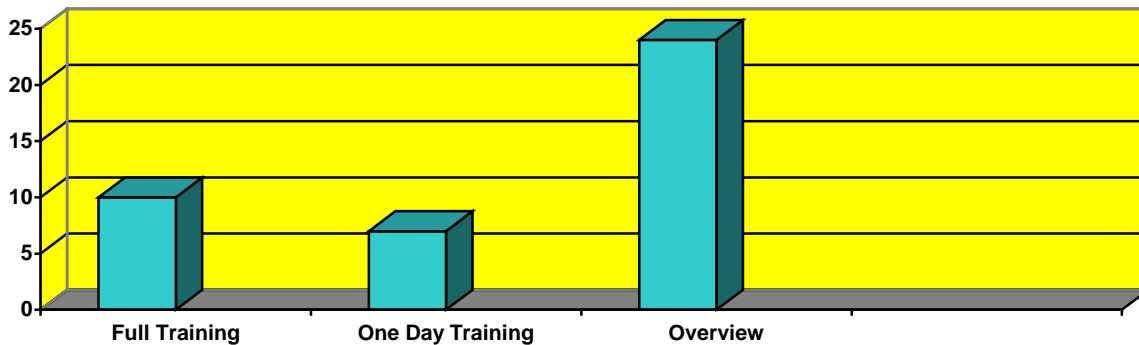
Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards Training Report 2005

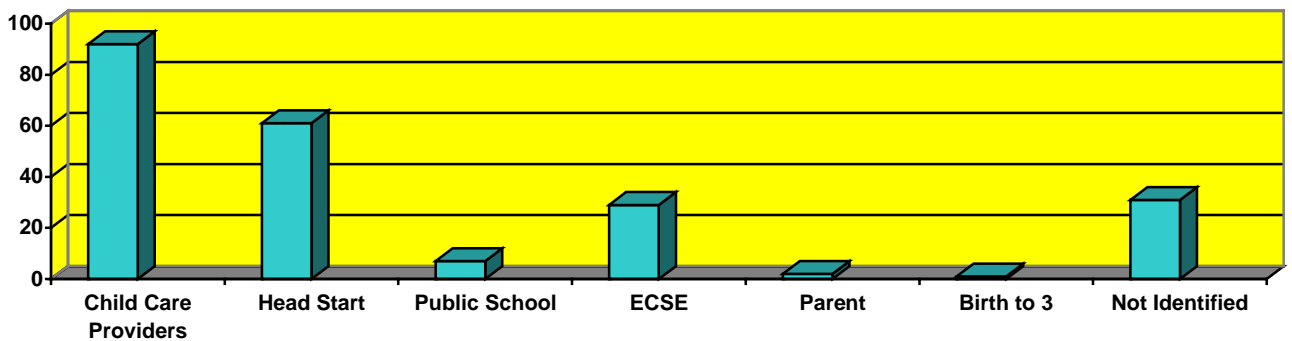

Emphasis has been placed on providing opportunity for multi-discipline practitioners to attend training together. Including child care, public school, Head Start, parents, and others in training sessions provides for rich conversation and shared learning across settings. Over 190 participants have completed the full-length training in 2005. Additionally, over 130 participants completed a single day training, and 500 individuals have participated in an overview session of the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards Training.
