The training allows us to take the next steps in responding to the change of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA): the provision of special education and related service in the least restrictive environment, individually determined for every child.

This training will also provide guidance on building partnerships with families in the transition process from Birth to 3 to Special Education Services from public schools. We hope to support a strong network among those working on behalf of children and families so that a strong continuum of placement options is available in the community.
