

Disability Services Agreement for Early Head Start

Early Head Start will collaborate with the identified Disability Specialist at the Kenosha Achievement Center when a known or suspected disability is identified as part of the Family Partnership development process.

Children under the age of three will be screened on a regular basis to determine age appropriate development. When a delay is suspected, the Family advocate will refer to the Disability Specialist for screening/evaluation by Early Intervention. Procedures outlined in the document for dually enrolled children, will be followed.

Children over the age of three and not yet in Head Start, who may have developmental delay, will be referred to the Early Childhood Program through Kenosha Unified School District #1.

When a Family Advocate identifies through parent interview, that there may be a disability identified in an older child or adult, the Advocate will contact the Disability Specialist for resources or referrals as appropriate.
