NEW! Online Event Calendar, Registration Process and more....

The CESA #12 Portal will give educators the ability to search for events, register online, and receive email confirmations for CESA staff development opportunities or meetings. The portal includes a calendar that will allow you to browse through scheduled events. The online registration process will provide users with an easy way to register for workshops with the added bonus of email notices and confirmations for each event. The Portal provides each user with their own account area that will keep track of your attendance in staff development events. Users can customize their portal account with web links and personal contacts. There is also a news and announcement feature that can be used to post both district and CESA wide news.

A MyCESA user is able to:

- Search and register for staff development events or meetings
- Decide if they wish to receive email notices of events of interest
- Retain a list of attended events when posted on the Portal
- Read district and CESA calendars
- Add links to their MyCESA page
- Add contacts from the Portal and DPI client lists
- Plus other items under development

IF YOU ARE A FIRST TIME USER...

The first step to accessing the CESA #12 Portal is to register as a portal user. To register for the Portal: Go to <http://www.mycesa.k12.wi.us>. Click on the "First Time User" link at the bottom of the page to get started! Be sure to choose CESA #12 under the Select Organization pull-down menu. Enter your own password and write it down. You will then receive an email approving your account. Please allow 72 hours for approval. You can modify your account at any time after your account has been approved. You will receive a "Confirmation of your application" message via email, indicating that you are a registered user, and at that point you may register for events and workshops. IF YOU ARE ALREADY A REGISTERED USER...

1. Go to the portal web address: <http://www.mycesa.k12.wi.us>
2. Enter your email address and password.
3. You should now be in the portal.
4. Click on the "Events" tab and do a search for the event you wish to register for.
5. Once you find the event, click on it to find out more details. If you wish to register, click on "Register Now" (*this should be to the right of the title*).
6. Continue until you see the "Confirm Registration" button and click on it.

That's all you need to do. You should receive an email within a couple of days to confirm your registration. If you have any questions, please let us know.
