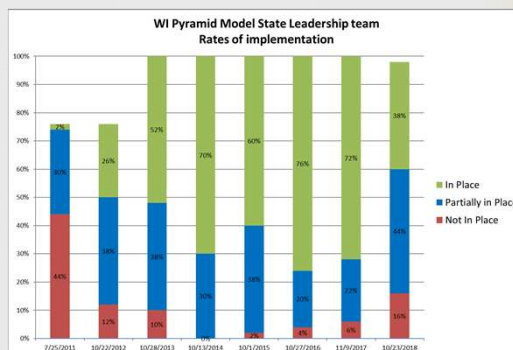

Pyramid Model Implementer Award Criteria



Selection Criteria:

1. Demonstration of successful implementation of practices across all levels of the Pyramid Model.
 - a. Clear and tangible evidence of implementation of the Pyramid Model, with fidelity (e.g., data, testimonials, and other measures demonstrating proof of successful implementation).
2. Demonstration of sustained implementation of practices across all levels of the Pyramid Model.
 - a. Clear and tangible evidence that the implementation of the Pyramid Model has been ongoing and sustained for over two or more years.
3. Demonstration of nominee's significant contributions to the broader community or field through the implementation of the Pyramid Model.
 - a. Clear and tangible evidence that the nominee has had a positive impact on children, families, program, and/or community with their use of the Pyramid Model (e.g., data, testimonials, and other measures demonstrating proof of impact).

Eligibility:

- An individual or team of individuals who support children, birth to 5 years old and their families using the Pyramid Model.
 - o If selected, the nominee or a designate is encouraged to be in attendance at the NTI conference to receive the award.
